Kindle Fire Installation

Use these instructions to download and install the cloudLibrary[™] by bibliotheca app on your Kindle Fire. This process requires Kindle 2nd generation and higher.

The Kindle app will **NOT** notify you of system updates. To get the latest version, uninstall and reinstall the app using the instructions below:

A. First, enabled your Kindle for apps from "unknown sources".

Kindle Fire

- 1. Go to the settings menu by tapping the settings icon (gear icon) or swiping down from the top of the screen.
- 2. Choose **Security** or **Device**.
- 3. Turn on the option, Allow installation of Applications from Unknown Sources.
- 4. Click Ok when the warning message appears and go back to the Home Screen.

Kindle HD

- 1. Swipe down from the top of the screen. This pulls up the **Quick Settings** menu.
- 2. Tap More.
- 3. Choose **Settings** then **Device.** On some Kindle Fires, you will need to go to **Applications.**
- 4. Tap on the option to turn on **Allow Installation of Applications from Unknown Sources.**
- 5. Go back to the Home Screen.
- B. You are now ready to download and install the cloudLibrary app. Please use the Silk browser on your Kindle to complete the following steps:
- 1. Open the Silk browser icon and navigate to www.yourcloudLibrary.com.
- 2. Tap on the **Fire** icon. This will bring you to the "Fire 2nd generation & up Installation" page.

- 3. Scroll down the page. Depending on your Kindle Fire generation model, tap either **2nd gen** or **3rd gen and up** download button. This will download the Kindle Fire App file to your device.
- 4. Tap OK to the download prompt message.
- 5. Tap open Download complete.
- 6. When asked "Do you want to install this application?", select install and then open.

Note: If your Fire is running OS 5.6.0.0, the install button may be greyed out. If this occurs, please press the Power Button to lock the device while on the install screen. Then press the Power Button again to unlock the device. This will allow the install button to be tapped.

- 7. When the app installed screen appears, tap **Done.**
- 8. Tap on the **Home** icon. If the cloudLibrary app isn't on your home screen go to "Apps"
- 9. Tap on the cloudLibrary icon to open the app. Perform the following steps inside the app:
 - a. Tap the screen and then tap the "Connect to Your Library" button.
 - b. Select your Country from the drop down and then choose your State.
 - c. Select your **Library** from the list.
 - d. Enter your **Library id and pin** if required and tap log in.

Installation is complete. You are ready to use the cloudLibrary.
