



DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
Camden County, North Carolina

WHEREAS, the County of Camden is currently in the path to experience the effects of Hurricane Florence; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described disaster, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Acting Chairman of the Camden County Board of Commissioners under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and the ordinance authorizing the Proclamation of a State of Emergency:

Section 1. A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the corporate jurisdiction of the County of Camden.


Section 2. The emergency area covered by this State of Emergency shall be the County's entire corporate jurisdiction.

Section 3. I hereby order all Camden County law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Pasquotank/Camden/City of Elizabeth City Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 4. I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.


Section 5. This declaration shall take effect at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
