Pasquotank, Camden and Elizabeth City Emergency Responders and personnel are currently assessing the potential impact of Hurricane Florence.

As of our morning update, we are expecting the arrival of tropical force winds by late Wednesday evening, into Thursday morning, with rain totals forecasted between seven and ten inches. Voluntary evacuation is in effect as of 2:00 p.m. today, and encouraged for those in low-lying, flood prone areas. The shelter at ECSU's Kermit E. White Graduate Center at 1704 Weeksville Road will be open and operational as of 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 12th. The shelter has a capacity of 300 persons; no pets are allowed. Transportation to the general public will be provided by ICPTA and may be requested by calling 252-335-4444. Please remember to bring personal hygiene items, medications, special dietary food items and clothing with you.

Although evacuation is not mandatory, please be advised that if you do not act within the time allotted, once the wind speeds and weather conditions escalate, emergency response may no longer be available.

The Emergency Operation Center will be fully operational as of 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 12th. All offices for Camden County, Pasquotank County and the City of Elizabeth City will be closed on Thursday, September 13th and Friday, September 14th. Essential personnel will report as directed.
